Strategic Foresight Course



ENRICH in LAC has initiated dialogues with ANII, the Uruguayan Agency for Research and Innovation; CIU, the Uruguayan Chamber of Industries; and LATU, the Technological Laboratory of Uruguay, looking forward to expanding the association's network and starting new collaborations. At UTEC, ENRICH in LAC in collaboration with ENRICH Global, is delivering the course module "Introduction to Strategic Foresight" to 20 staff members of the innovation department. The course concept developed by DLR-PT consists of a total of 4 modules, finalizing with a "Train-the-Facilitator" module aimed at training future foresight trainers.

Country Profile: Mexico, EU & LAC Region



"Bilateral trade between Mexico and the EU have more than tripled in the past 20 years, making the EU Mexico's second-biggest export market. Mexico was also the first partner country to create a complementary funding for Mexican researchers to join successful projects of Horizon 2020."

Mexico is the 16th-largest economy and the largest Spanish-speaking country in the world. Mexico has generally enjoyed slow, but stable economic growth since the 1990s. Its USD 1.29 trillion economy is the second-largest in Latin America, and the country maintains deep trade and investment ties with the United States. Mexico remains an upper–middle-income member of the G-20 and OECD with a per capita GDP of USD 10,040 (ITA, 2022).

The aim is to deliver relevant content to those who follow the interests and synergies that the ENRICH in LAC initiative creates between Europe and Latin America through a dynamic and short video.

On October 2022, it was time for the ReSiELP Project. It is funded by the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT) and is supported by the Knowledge and Innovation Communities Raw Materials (KIC RM) in the category: Recycling and material chain optimization for End-of-Life products. The purpose of this grant was to provide travel grants for feasibility visits or for participating on international fair and conferences.

NEW GRANTS

The National Council of Science and Technology (Conacyt) launched on 15 November a call "Puerta Horizonte Europa-Mexico", which aims to encourage the participation of Mexican entities in the Horizon Europe Programme and strengthen bilateral relations between the EU and Mexico in Science, Technology and Innovation. This new mechanism proposes two modalities: Institutions with their own resources may apply under Modality 1 and can apply in all areas of Horizon Europe calls. Under modality 2 Conacyt will fund a maximum of 8 projects in the areas of health, energy and human security.
